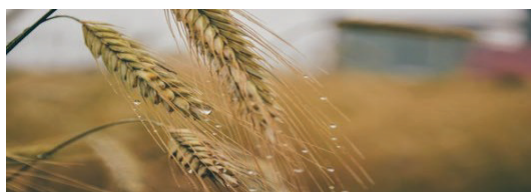
- Entry fee per exhibit – \$1.00 inc GST must accompany entry form.
- All produce to be grown by the exhibitor. Must be grown within 50kms of Callington.
- Variety to be correctly named on all entries, with section and class labels
- **GRAIN SAMPLES** from season 2017-2018, taken off header (not recleaned). Provide a minimum of 2kgs for each entry. GRAIN SAMPLE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM, AND FEES, and delivered to Convenor - ENTRIES CLOSE 15th OCTOBER.
- **PRE-HARVEST SAMPLES** to be 15cm diameter where tied - ENTRIES CLOSE 19th OCTOBER.
- **HAY SAMPLES** to be a wad/biscuit taken from small square or round bales. Approx. 2kg supplied in plastic bag ENTRIES CLOSE 19th OCTOBER.
- **PRE-HARVEST & HAY** exhibits must be delivered on **Saturday 27th October** to the **Grain Marquee** on the **Callington Oval** between **7.30am** and **12noon.**
- Exhibits to be staged by **12noon** for judging at **12:30pm.**
- All entries will be on display in the **Grain Marquee** on the **Callington Oval** on **Sunday 28th October.**
- **NO EXHIBIT** to be removed before **4.15pm** on **Sunday 28th October.**
- **Any exhibit not collected before 4.45pm** on **Sunday 28th October** will be disposed of.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners of each class will receive a certificate.
- Prize money will be awarded 1st - \$2.00, 2nd – \$1.00.
- Champion Sash will be awarded to most outstanding exhibit in each section.
- Grand Champion Sash will be presented to the **best overall** exhibit.
- Aggregate Sash will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most overall points.
