2018 Area of focus – HERITAGE

Topic – MINING CHIMNEYS – Bremer, Paringa and Aclare

To enter the Callington Triple Challenge you will need to complete ALL the following 3 tasks related to this year's topic.

TASK 1: 2D

To be on mounting boards no bigger than A4

Draw, paint, photograph a local mining chimney using any medium.

TASK 2: 3D

160cm² eg (40cm x 40cm) maximum base board, and not to exceed 40cm in height

Make a 3 dimensional model of the chimney you have presented as your 2D entry in Task 1.

TASK 3: Written piece

To be presented in A4 plastic sleeve (for pinning up) (limit 1 page)

What can you find out about mining chimneys and tell us about them? Write about your chimney telling us as much as you can about its purpose, history and construction.
